

Summary of the June 27, 2016 Bi-monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chair George Franckowiak. Motion to approve the agenda was moved, second and unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

Pot holes-Supervisor Opack stated that Shawn Frye from Asphalt Duluth has put together a work order to do the work on the Town Hall parking lot and the Gnesen Community Center parking lot. Chair Franckowiak hasn't talked to the Church Council about the matter of the potholes in front of the church. It was decided to remove this from the agenda and we will take all of our projects and prioritize them.

Roof repair at the Community Center-We have not received a quote from Ward Poppenberg Construction as of tonight and so we will add it to the projects mentioned above for prioritizing.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Case-We received notice of the bankruptcy case. Clerk will send an email to the trustee mentioned on the notice and ask if we need to submit/file anything and if we should be in attendance at the July 11th bankruptcy meeting.

St. Louis County Planning & Community Development Department-We received a letter with the proposed revision to St. Louis County Subdivision Ordinance 60 and St. Louis County Zoning Ordinance 62. The town clerk will make copies for the Town Board and the Planning and Zoning Board. Public Comments are due by August 1, 2016. Our P&Z Board has gone through the comments Gil had on our Zoning Ordinance changes.

P&Z Violation-The town clerk will talk to St. Louis County Sheriff Ross Litman to see what our next step should be-can we have a deputy deliver a letter telling the violator what will be required of him to meet the zoning regulations on the violation on his property.

Fireworks sales-We received phone calls from someone wanting to sell fireworks by the Boondock's Saloon on Rice Lake Road. He was referred to St. Louis County.
