

Summary of the bi-monthly meeting of the Town of Gnesen that was held on Monday, November 14, 2016, at the Gnesen Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chair George Franckowiak. The Town Board, Town Employees and three residents stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Motion to approve the agenda was moved by Supervisor David Opack, second by Chair George Franckowiak and unanimously approved. Minutes of the October 10, 2016 and the October 24, 2016 meetings were unanimously approved with a motion by Chair Franckowiak, second by Supervisor Opack.

Motion by Supervisor Opack second by Chair Franckowiak, all in favor to accept the Treasurer's report. (There were no outstanding checks for the month.)

OLD BUSINESS:

Roof repair-We received a check from our insurance company for the additional damage to the Community Center roof. The roof repair has been completed.

P&Z matter-Our lawyer stated that the complaint will be delivered this week to the person in violation of our zoning.

Community Block Grant Meeting-Supervisor Nelson was not in attendance tonight to give an update.

Snow blower attachment-Has been ordered.

NEW BUSINESS:

Gnesen Volunteer Fire Department-Several members of the fire department were in attendance tonight asking about different financing options to purchase a fire truck. Supervisor Opack suggested that they talk to Supervisor Nelson as he has worked with non-profit organizations and he might have some suggestions. The town clerk will send an email to our lawyer to see what we can do as far as helping the fire department in obtaining financing.

Grader operator's road report-Tom Haller stated he checked the roads today. The roads are all in good condition. Tom mentioned that the truck is still in the way for snowplowing on Lakeview Drive and that the hole in West Pioneer Road where they removed the fence post has been filled. Supervisor Opack mentioned that the Berg Road road sign is missing. The clerk will email the County to have another one installed. Clerk mentioned that the West Pioneer Road has been striped.

Gnesen Community Center Building Manager report-Toni Blomdahl was not in attendance tonight. Supervisor Opack mentioned that he and John Larson shot a grade on the skating rink and the rink area is level. The fire department will flood the rink again this year at the community center.

Gnesen Community Newspaper-Cindy Erickson was not in attendance tonight.

Destroy records per the Records Retention Schedule-Supervisor Opack made a motion, second by Chair Franckowiak and unanimously approved to destroy the Board of Appeals Petitions for 1987-1995 and the 2014 Primary and General Elections results.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Two piece of correspondence were received.

Nine building permits were turned in for the month of October 2016.

The board read over the checks and Supervisor Opack made a motion, second by Chair Franckowiak and unanimously approved to pay Claims #13692-13728 plus four electronic withdrawals.
